

EVERGREENS

***Juniperus communis depressa* 'AmiDak'**

Height: 1'
Spread: 4-5'

Blueberry Delight Juniper

Foliage: Dark green
Zone: 3-7

Dense, low spreading Juniper with rich, dark green needles with a contrasting silvery blue line on the upper leaf surface. Full Sun

***Juniperus virginiana* 'Taylor'**

Height: 25'
Spread: 3'

Taylor Juniper

Foliage: Green-gray
Zone: 4-7

A great plant discovered near Taylor, NE in the late 1970's by Allen Wilke. Distinctive upright, narrow form, tight growing. Foliage is a medium green with a hint of gray, darkening slightly in the winter. Tolerant of poor, dry sites and high pH soils. * 2003 *GreatPlants Intro*.

Picea omorika

Height: 50-60'
Spread: 20-30'

Serbian Spruce

Foliage: Green
Zone: 4-7

An attractive narrowly pyramidal evergreen with short, shiny green needles that have 2 distinctive, broad white bands on the lower surface. One of the more adaptable spruces that tolerates dry conditions well.

Pinus bungeana

Height: 30-50'
Spread: 20-35'

Lacebark Pine

Foliage: Bright green
Zone: 4

This evergreen is pyramidal to rounded, often with many trunks in youth, becoming open, and picturesque with age. The bark exfoliates in patches like a plane tree, young branches greenish with irregular whitish or brownish areas interspersed. A quality specimen plant. * 2008 *GreatPlants Winner*
